- The local church is the starting point of world missions.
- Cross cultural ministry beyond West Michigan is valued as a means to enhance a Christian's worldview and is a means to expand the reach of the church.
- Training of national pastors and their leaders to reach and serve their own people is a high value.
- Reproductive church planting and church planting movements, especially those that take place in the "10/40 Window," are a high priority.
